RECYCLING VOCABULARY. HOW TO MAKE IT STICK.

The objective of my session is to introduce teachers to various effective methods of working with lexical items in the classroom, allowing students to encounter, memorize, and apply the vocabulary they encounter during their lessons. The important addition to it will be strategies to identify and effectively teach the language that our students specifically need for their language development. During the presentation, we will explore three essential pillars of recycling: providing sufficient input, incorporating communicative tasks, and fostering the development of noticing skills. These pillars serve as crucial elements in maximizing vocabulary retention and language acquisition. To enhance practical application, I will present eight hands-on tasks that teachers can immediately implement in their classes. These tasks are designed to actively engage students and reinforce the newly learned vocabulary. By incorporating these tasks, teachers will be equipped with actionable strategies that can be utilized in their lessons starting from the following day.
